Day 1 - December 9th

This morning we will depart from Asbury Church in Madison at 6:00 a.m., picking up at Mayfair Church in Huntsville at 6:30. We will have a breakfast stop in Stevenson AL, as we travel through Knoxville to Bristol, VA for an included lunch.

Our over-night stay will be in Harrisonburg, PA.

Day 2 – December 10th – (bags outside your room at 6:30)

7:30 a.m. – Today we will see much of Washington, DC. Our 1st stop is the new Museum of the Bible in Washington DC. This afternoon we will have a Monument tour, Ford’s Theatre tour, Capitol Tour with Congressman Mo Brooks and an included dinner in Aberdeen MD, where we over-night.

Day 3 – December 11th - (bags outside your room by 7:00 a.m.)

8:00 a.m. – Our 3-hour drive this morning brings us to Liberty Park where we board our boat to Ellis Island and Liberty Island providing stunning views of the New York City skyline. We will have lunch at the Statue of Liberty, a gift of international friendship from the people of France to the U.S. and one of the most universal symbols of political freedom and democracy. Ellis Island is a symbol of America’s immigrant heritage. From 1892 to 1954, this immigrant depot processed the greatest tide of incoming humanity in the nation’s history. Nearly twelve million landed here in their search of freedom of speech and religion, and for economic opportunity. We check into our New York City hotel for the next 3 nights - Hotel Edison in Times Square. We have a special included dinner planned tonight before we take in the Christmas Spectacular Rockettes performance at Radio City Music Hall. This has been one of the hottest holiday tickets in New York City since 1932. You will take a 3D ride through the skies of New York with Santa, be whisked up to the North Pole and immersed in a wonderland. After the show we will take a short walk back to our hotel and stop to watch the skaters at the rink at Rockefeller Center. Tonight, we will get a feel for “The City that Never Sleeps” right outside our hotel doors.

Day 4 – December 12th

This morning have breakfast at one of the many restaurants around the hotel. Good Morning America is just 2 blocks from our hotel, so you may want to take a chance at being on morning TV. At 9:00, our step on guide, Dennis will meet us at the hotel to begin our city touring of Upper and Midtown Manhattan to include Lincoln Center, Upper West Side, a visit to the Cathedral of St. John the Divine, Harlem, Fifth Avenue and a walk in Central Park. We will have lunch at Rockefeller Center or Grand Central Station, one of the most beautiful buildings in NY. We will drive through the Garment District, Madison Square Garden, Macy’s and visit the Chelsea Market, if time allows. The grand finale of this day’s touring takes us to Top of the Rock to view the Empire State Building and the many iconic skyscrapers in The Big Apple. Tonight, we will have many suggestions of things you might like to do, to include taking in a Broadway Play. The ticket kiosk is right outside our hotel.

Day 5 – December 13th

After breakfast on your own, we will begin the 2nd part of our city tour at 9:00 a.m. with our tour guide, Dennis. This morning we will go to the 9/11 Memorial, the Wall Street District, Greenwich Village, SoHo and the Brooklyn Bridge. This is a bargain shopping day in Little Italy and Chinatown, where you will also have lunch. We will set a time to come back to the hotel and rest before having free time to take in dinner, roam around in Times Square, visit the gorgeous windows at Saks Fifth Ave and Macy’s at night-time, or take in a play.

Day 6 – December 14th (bags outside your room at 6:30 a.m.)

7:30 – We begin our trek to Gettysburg, PA where we have tickets reserved for the Cyclorama, the Battle of Gettysburg in Art. Reservations are made for our group at the Historic 1776 Dobbin House Tavern, a colonial restaurant where candlelit elegance, superior food in abundance, and gracious service bring back the sights, sounds and tastes of two centuries ago.

We will visit our Alabama Monument on the Gettysburg battlefield and visit Little Roundtop. We will have dinner at Cracker Barrel and settle into our hotel in Harrisonburg, PA.

Day 7 – December 15th (bags outside your room at 7:00)

8:00 a.m. We will have movies, games and lunch at The Cheesecake Factory in Knoxville on our way home. A perfect time to chat with your friends about all the fun things you’ve done and the great sights you’ve seen. Arrival home is planned for approximately 7:00 p.m.
