The Music Man follows fast-talking traveling salesman, Harold Hill (played by Stephen Tyler Davis), as he cons the people of River City, Iowa, into buying instruments and uniforms for a boys' band that he vows to organize – this, despite the fact that he doesn't know a trombone from a treble clef.

Harold teaches discordant neighbors to live in harmony — quite literally — by transforming the town's bickering school board into a barbershop quartet.

One of the most universally cherished treasures of American musical theater, The Music Man was an instant smash hit when it premiered on Broadway on December 19, 1957. It went on to win five Tony Awards, including the prize for Best Musical, and ran for 1,375 performances. The production is a feelgood show with plenty of humor and heart and is perfect for the whole family.
